*How can you be sure you know what to do after a car accident?
We can help. Please review the 8 easy tips below. You may consider keeping
a copy in your vehicle.*

1. If someone is injured, call 911 immediately. Otherwise, call the police or fire department to report your accident.
2. Take steps to prevent further accidents and/or injury. If permissible, and the police or fire department suggest so, move your vehicle to the side of the road or other safe place.
3. Do not leave the scene of the accident until it is appropriate to do so.
4. At the accident scene, do not discuss the specifics of the accident with anyone, except the police, fire department, or other emergency personnel.
5. Exchange your name, insurance company, policy number and vehicle's license plate number with the other driver(s).
6. If safe to do so, consider taking photos of the accident scene and vehicles.
7. As soon as possible after an accident, call The Hartford's 24-hour toll-free hot line at 1-800-243-5860 to report your claim. Or, report your claim online at <http://www.hartfordauto.com>.
8. Consider using our Auto Repair Shop Network with a lifetime workmanship guarantee. Ask your Customer Care Representative or visit www.thehartford.com/autorepairshops to find a local network repair shop. As always, you may select the shop of your choice.
